Our Capital Campaign Begins!

After much prayer and time spent developing our Master Plan for the Sacred Heart Parish campus, and following a very positive feasibility study, Fr. Ritter and our parish leadership joyfully announce the beginning of our ***Honoring Our Legacy, Celebrating Our Faith, Building Our Community Capital Campaign***. Our goal with this campaign is to raise \$8.3 million to fund and complete all of the projects in Priority I of our Master Plan. The Priority I projects are:

New School Administration Wing
Replace Pastoral Services Administration Building
Re-roof Existing Annex
Existing Gym Upgrade
Renovate Current School Office Space into Two New Classrooms
Science Lab & Kitchen Renovation
New Maintenance/Storage Building (Temporary)
Site Entry, Roads, and Parking Modification

We begin this campaign mindful of the sacrifices and generosity that have helped us achieve so much already as a faith community. We are grateful for this generosity. Throughout our campaign, all parishioners will be asked to consider sharing their time, talents and treasure to help the parish succeed in this endeavor.
